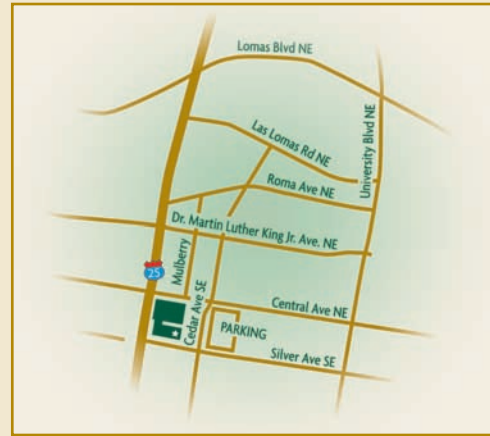

Insurance and Payment Policies

Perinatal Associates will file insurance forms for all services performed in our office or at the hospital. We only ask that patients bring either an insurance form or insurance card with them for their initial visit.

All patients are required to pay 20% of charges at the time of service. This includes patients who have no insurance or whose insurance does not include maternity coverage. The only exception is for patients covered by an HMO who will be responsible for making their own co-payment. Payment schedules for any balance due must be arranged with our Billing office.

We are participating providers with Presbyterian Health Plan, Presbyterian Salud, Cimarron Health Plan, Molina Salud, United Healthcare, Admar, Blue Cross Blue Shield of NM, Tricare, Medicaid and Indian Health Service, Principal, Mutual of Omaha and Great West.

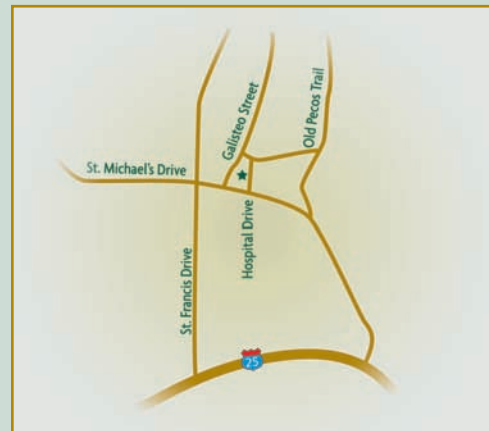

Perinatal Associates

Perinatal Associates of New Mexico, Ltd., is a group of physicians specializing in high-risk pregnancies. All of the physician members of this group are Perinatologists (i.e. Obstetricians that have received an additional two years of fellowship training in high-risk pregnancies). This training involves intensive care and use of specialized obstetrical equipment including ultrasound.

Our team of doctors, nurse practitioners, genetic counselors and other trained professionals are here to help you with your pregnancy. Working together, we want to assist you in overcoming problems during this potentially stressful time. We welcome any questions you may have about your treatment and your pregnancy.

AIUM Accreditation

Accreditation by the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine (AIUM) demonstrates a facility's clinical excellence and its commitment to the highest quality patient care when providing diagnostic ultrasound services. To become accredited, a practice must undergo a rigorous and detailed application process.

AIUM accreditation, which is a voluntary process, gives patients the assurance that a facility is qualified to perform their ultrasound examinations.

Referrals

Patients at Perinatal Associates are accepted only by referral from their personal physician for medical, obstetrical or genetic complications of pregnancy or for pregnancy consultations. They continue to be under the care of their personal physician unless care is transferred to Perinatal Associates.

Referrals are made to Perinatal Associates; not to a particular physician. All patients will be seen by one or more of the physicians at Perinatal Associates during the course of their care.

Hospitals

The physicians practice primarily at Presbyterian Hospital downtown.

Prenatal Genetic Counseling

Genetic counseling can help you understand the risk for birth defects or genetic disorders in your current pregnancy.

A board-certified genetic counselor with a master's degree and/or a board-certified clinical geneticist-physician provide these critical services. We aim to encourage people to make decisions that reflect their own personal and cultural beliefs, values and goals. Women over the age of 35, or who have other risk factors such as a family history of birth defects or genetic disorders, exposure to medications, drugs or chemicals, abnormal AFP results, multiple miscarriages, or diabetes, may be candidates for genetic counseling.

If needed, testing such as ultrasounds, amniocentesis, percutaneous umbilical blood sampling (PUBS), and other tests are offered and can be performed by the physicians of Perinatal Associates to determine if the current pregnancy may be affected. Prenatal genetic counseling is done prior to any fetal diagnostic testing.

Obstetrical Ultrasound

Obstetrical ultrasound is a safe imaging technique that allows the provider to examine the fetus. The physicians at Perinatal Associates personally perform all Level III exams and fetal echocardiograms in addition to reviewing all ultrasounds performed by our service. Ultrasound may be used to confirm dates, evaluate growth, examine for birth defects or examine the fetal heart. We will answer any questions you may have about your ultrasound.

Amniocentesis

Amniocentesis is a safe, proven technique that has been used for many years. This test is performed for various fetal diagnostic procedures depending on the individual case. Ultrasound guidance is used during amniocentesis to assure safe removal of amniotic fluid. Our physicians have performed over 10,000 genetic amniocenteses. As with all testing procedures performed at Perinatal Associates, patients receive counseling about amniocentesis prior to the test to assure that they understand the risks, benefits, and limitations as well as the process in detail.
